

April Block Swap

Pastel Pinwheels

Block Size: 9" unfinished

Make 12 blocks to trade (+ 1 for Community Quilts if you wish).

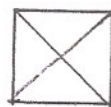
Yardage: 1/3 yard pastel for main pinwheel

1/2 yard pastel with a small print for the background

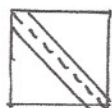
Cut 24 3-7/8" squares of main fabric

24 3-7/8" squares of background fabric

12 7-1/4" squares background cut these squares into 4 triangles cutting across the diagonal both twice.



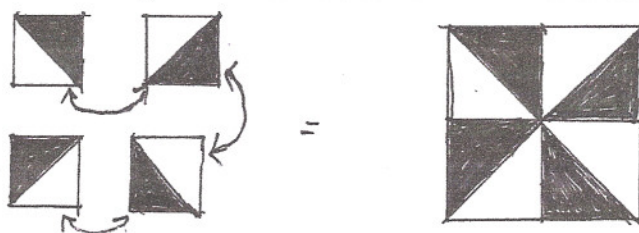
Place one main color square and one background square right sides together and draw a line from corner to corner diagonally.



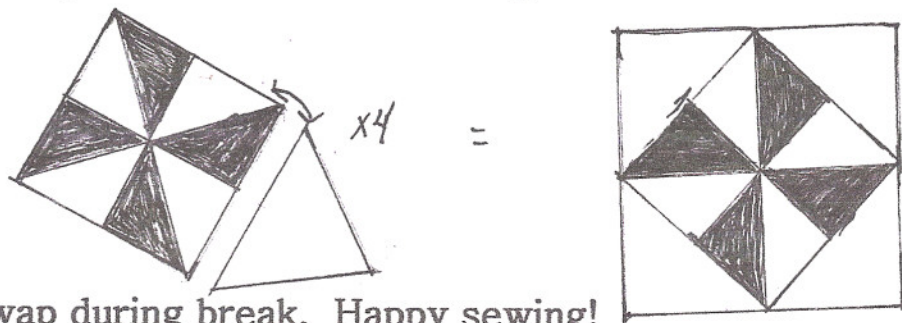
cut on the

Sew 1/4 inch on each side of the line,

feel free to use whatever method you prefer. Sew the squares together to form a pinwheel as shown in the diagram.



Sew the 4 background triangles to the sides of the pinwheel to set the pinwheel on point as shown in the diagram.
