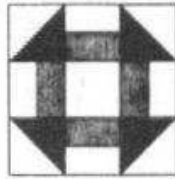


February Swap



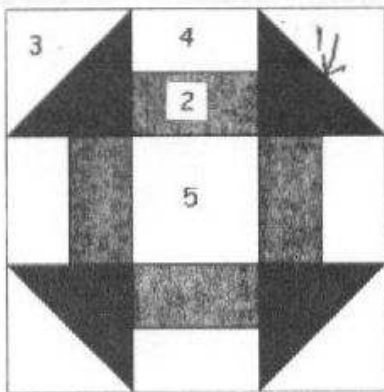
Churn Dash Block

size - 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished - make 12 blocks (+ 1 for Community Quilts, if you wish)

Yardage: use 2 Green fabrics - darker green for half-square triangles - buy $\frac{3}{8}$ yd.
lighter green for side rectangles - buy $\frac{1}{4}$ yd.

cream-on-cream fabric for background - buy $\frac{5}{8}$ yd.

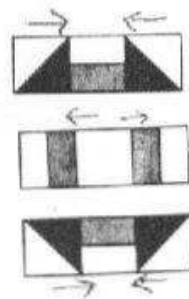
- Directions below are for 1 block. For multiple blocks, 3" finished triangle paper works well for constructing pieces #1 & #3. Strip piecing works well for #2 & #4. Please use whatever method you wish to construct your 12 blocks.



Darker green #1 - cut 2 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares - cut in half diagonally
Lighter green #2 - cut 4 2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
Cream fabric #3 - cut 2 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares - cut in half diagonally
Cream #4 - cut 4 2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
Cream #5 - cut 1 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square

- Piecing:
Make 4 half-square triangles, pairing #1 & #3. Press to dark.
Make 4 rectangle pairs, USING #2 & #4. Press to dark.

Piece 3 rows together - using piece #5 in center.
Press in direction of arrows on right.



Complete unit measures 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
